

# GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA

## ACTION PLAN ON DRUG ABUSE CONTROL FOR THE PERIOD 2006 – 2009

FEBRUARY 2006

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## 1. INTRODUCTION

The action plan on drug abuse control for the period from 2006 to 2009 represents a special form of an implementation plan, by which the competent state administration bodies, regional self-government bodies and non-governmental organisations try to concrete the goals and measures of the National Drug Control Strategy in the period from 2006 to 2012, which is considered the most important strategic document in the field of drug abuse control. The measures and activities anticipated by the action plan are defined and based on the evaluation of the previous Action plan and new requirements in professional approaches, based on the national strategy guidelines.

The goal we want to achieve by the Action plan is efficient, coordinated and systematic drug abuse control in the Republic of Croatia, and a more efficient application of the measures which aim to reduce health and social consequences of drug abuse in society; drug use incidence within the population - especially among children and youth; to improve the family protection measures and integrate all segments of society in the activities related to drug abuse control.

It is not enough to apply the measures and activities mentioned in the action plan on drug abuse control only on the state level, the local and regional self-government units and non-governmental organisations that in their activities carry the partial responsibility for the systematic and continuous implementation of the drug abuse control measures, should be also included in the implementation.

The right to healthy life is one of the basic rights arising from the Constitution of the Republic of Croatia and international conventions and represent the right of an individual, especially children, youth and family to be protected from social and other circumstances favourable toward drug abuse. In order to achieve this right, all the subjects in society should be engaged in the promotion and implementation of the programmes for addiction prevention, treatment and rehabilitation of drug users, programmes for assistance and protection of families, as well as the drug availability reduction on all levels, from combating organised crime to street reduction.

Starting from the national strategy's basic principles, especially the decentralisation principle, the action plan aims at the equal availability of the variety of programmes and activities throughout Croatia, in accordance with the real needs of the particular local communities (i.e. counties). Therefore, networks of various programmes in the drug abuse field should be developed and they the activities dealing with the drug abuse harmonised with the measures on the state level in order to accomplish the principle goals of the National strategy and to achieve the drug supply and the drug demand reduction.

Regarding the previous reports on the implementation of the National strategy it has been noticed that in every ministry and every state administration body there are programmes currently being implemented in accordance with the national drug abuse control strategy. However, further efforts should be put into their implementation to advance them and to contribute to better implementation of the measures from the National strategy and Action plan. Furthermore, coordination and cooperation between the state bodies themselves, the state bodies and the local administration and local self-government (regional) bodies and between the state institutions and civil organisations should be promoted.

Since the reports have shown numerous negative trends relating to drug abuse in the Republic of Croatia, such as increased drug use among youth, increased number of drug addicts and the number of prisoners addicted to drugs, the number of deaths caused by drug use, even the number of child-bearing women drug addicts, the action plan should point out the priorities for the above mentioned period as follows:

1. Establishing and improving the network of the institutions for combating addiction on the state and local level
2. Promotion and improvement of preventive programmes for children and youth, and prevention programmes in the workplace, especially those with special working conditions
3. Enforce the activities on the local community level and the activities of non-governmental organisations
4. Strengthen the repression apparatus measures for preventing drug availability and drug control, and improve the penal policy toward convicts addicted to drugs.
5. Promote the measures of treatment and resocialisation of addicts and establish the multidisciplinary teams for working with them and their families.
6. Provide larger financial resources for the implementation of the programme on the state level and professionally build up teams in state institutions for the implementation of all action plan programmes.
7. Encourage, carry out and financially support scientific research in the addiction field.

Everything previously mentioned is necessary in order to be able to successfully confront the addiction as a today's global problem and provide assistance to families, promote the health protection measures of children and youth, assure the rights of individuals and community to personal safety and protection through reducing all kinds of the secondary drug - related crime.

Consequently, the action plan represents concrete measures where the principle goal is promotion of the comprehensive drug abuse control programme in the Republic of Croatia.

In order to realise this goal, interdepartmental activities and shared responsibility is required. This multi-faceted problem requires multi-disciplinary action from different sectors, especially on the local and community level, which should be creators of the prevention programme on the local level. On the national level different conditions for the implementation of the national strategy programmes and action plan programmes should be assured, such as financial, legislative and institutional ones. The very important role of civil society should not be neglected, especially the importance of the cooperation between the state institutions and non-governmental organisations for the implementation of the drug demand reduction.

## 2. METHODOLOGY OF THE ELABORATED ACTION PLAN

The action plan on drug abuse control has been created for the period from the year 2006 to 2009, and it more precisely defines the priorities, individual goals, the ways of their realisation, implementation deadlines and evaluation of the financial resources needed for the mentioned budgetary period, regarding the scope of the activities of competent state administration bodies, local (regional) self-government bodies, and all other subjects on the national and local level.

The main carrier of every particular measure and activity has been defined. It is a competent Ministry or a state administration body, local self-government bodies and other carriers, who propose the measure. The main carrier appoints the associates for the implementation of the proposed measures and activities, i.e. other bodies responsible for their implementation. The main carrier is responsible for the implementation of such measures and activities in due time.

The Drug Abuse Control Committee of the Republic of Croatia creates the annual programmes for the implementation of the action plan measures and activities, while the Office for Combating Narcotic Drug Abuse of the Republic of Croatia monitors their implementation, through the cooperation and coordination with the state administration bodies, local (regional) self-government bodies and non-governmental organisations.

The action plan is tied to its content and term structure and the national strategy goals, which were adopted by the Croatian Parliament on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2005 and represent the basic document for its implementation in the period from 2006 to 2009.

## 3. GOALS OF THE ACTION PLAN

The principle goals of the action plan measures and activities are tied to two main goals of the national strategy: drug demand reduction and drug supply reduction, whereas the special action plan goals have been defined in accordance with the action plan fields and anticipated measures and activities.

## 4. AREAS INCLUDED IN THE ACTION PLAN

The action plan should achieve the responsibility of the activity and measures carriers in particular areas relating to drug abuse control described in the national strategy. The action plan comprises the areas as follows:

1. Coordination
2. Monitoring and information system
3. Research
4. Evaluation
5. Addiction prevention among children and youth
6. Addiction prevention through family protection measures
7. Addiction prevention in the educational system
8. Addiction prevention in the health system
9. Addiction prevention in the local community
10. Addiction prevention in the workplace
11. Drug addicts' health care
  - tasks of health professionals and health institutions
  - treatment
  - harm reduction – harm that has arisen from drug use
12. Programmes for solving social problems
13. Therapeutic communities and addiction rehabilitation centres
14. Addicts' resocialisation
15. Cooperation with non-governmental organisations and civil society activities
16. Prevention of illegal drug manufacture
17. Control over precursors
18. Combating drug-related crime
19. Penal policy
20. International cooperation
21. Training
22. Financial resources needed for the implementation of the action plan

The action plan has defined special goals, measures, implementation activities, implementation deadlines, carriers, associates, financial resources, measures and activities implementation indicators for each of these areas.

#### **4. 1. COORDINATION**

##### **4.1.1.Goal**

Make a maximum effort in the planning and the implementation of the drug abuse control programmes on the national level. Promote the coordination and cooperation among competent ministries and state administration bodies and the institutions on the local level. This is in order to contribute to a more efficient and continuous implementation of all National strategy measures and ensure a balanced, integrated approach to the drug problem.

##### **4.1.1.1. Measures**

Continuous monitoring of the implementation of the action plan and national strategy measures and activities through continuous coordination and cooperation with the competent state administration bodies and local (regional) self-government, as well as other institutions on the state and local level, and non-governmental organisations.

## **4. 2. MONITORING AND INFORMATION SYSTEM**

### **4.2.1. Goals**

Put additional efforts into making a comprehensive information system that will monitor the addiction problem in all its segments and sectors, adjust the current monitoring systems according to the standards and requirements of the European Union and integrate it into an international data base system, support and improve the information systems per individual sectors and continue with the implementation of the specific international research among risky populations, develop the research by using new fast methods.

#### **4.2.1.1. Measures**

Establishing the integrated information system on drugs and consequent drug addiction, development of the standardised ways of collecting and utilisation of the data from various fields, in accordance with the competences and the scope of activity of particular subjects included in the drug abuse control system of the Office for Combating Narcotic Drug Abuse, as the body responsible for the coordination of the activities in the drug abuse control field.
